Hand Puppets

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Little Ladybird seeks a Husband

Instructions

Puppets are a great tool you can use to stretch your imagination. Puppets can be made using any supplies you like. That's why there are different types of puppets: hand puppets and stick puppets, finger puppets, paper bag puppets, and even sock puppets.

Hand puppets demand a little work because you need to hand sew front and back felt pieces together. You may then ask an adult to help you. When your puppets are all done, you may start staging a performance at home, or at school, and invite your friends. In the next pages you'll find **templates** to creatr the main characters taken from Little Ladybird seeks a Husband.

Supplies you need for each puppet:

- 1. one A4 white cardboard sheet
- 2. Body and head: felt in the colours you like
- 3. Details (nose, ears, belly, others): pieces of scrap coloured felts. Make the eyes out of felt, or buy google eyes instead
- 4. Sewing needle and thread in the colours matching the felts; thimble
- 5. Fabric scissors
- 6. Black marker
- 7. Glue (optional)

Instructions:

- 1. Print out the template(s) on a A4 white cardboard sheet.
- 2. Cut out the template with the scissors. Then cut out your puppet out of the felt. For some puppets length must be increased (*centimetres as shown on the template*) when cutting out of the felt. *Be careful with the scissors!*
- 3. Apply/sew the details (mouth, nose, eyes, etc.) to the front piece of the puppet.
- 4. Hand sew the front and the back pieces together.
- 5. Paint any final detail, for example whiskers or eyebrows.
